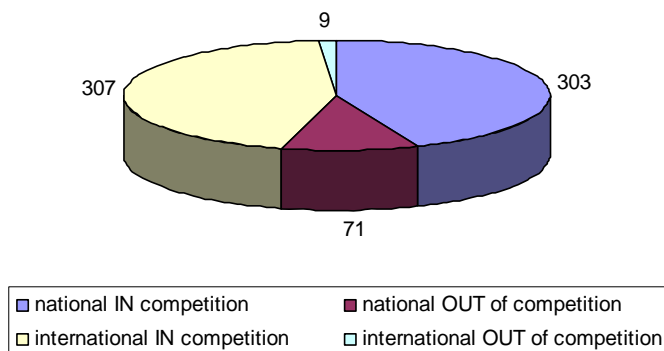


**ANNUAL REPORT**

Anti-Doping Agency of Serbia until December 31<sup>st</sup>, carried out **690** doping controls. Doping control officers participated in international competitions in and out of Serbia, at national competitions, equestrian sport and out of competition also in and out of our country

In 2010. we carried out 15 blood screening of cyclist.

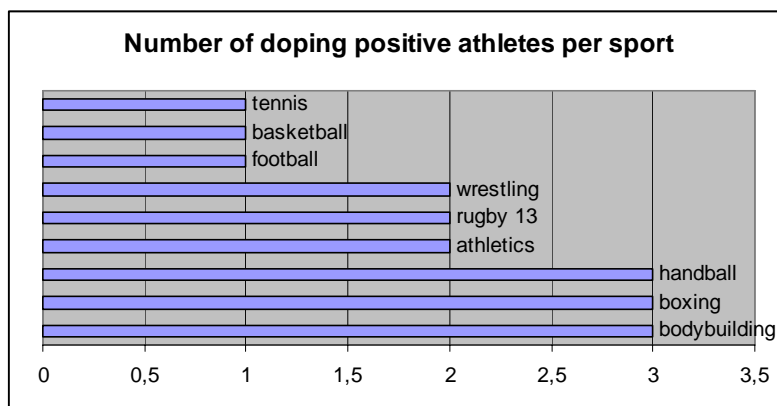

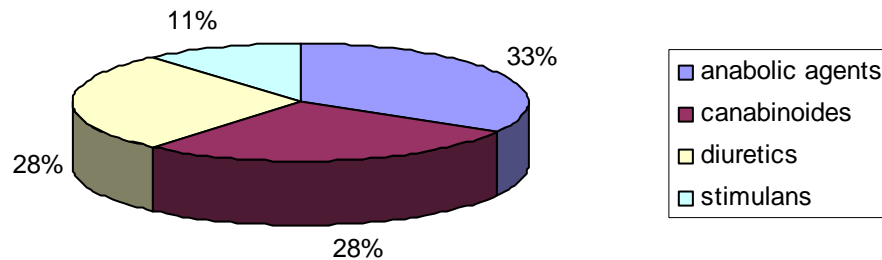

Anti-Doping Agency of Serbia received announce of International Sports Federation of two doping positive Serbian athletes tested abroad:

In addition to regular activities in planning and carrying out doping controls, ADAS is also engaged in other areas. The first is education of all those involved in sport. During 2010 was held a large number of dial-lectures by sports associations. Also, we participated at meetings organized by WADA, RADO Eastern Europe, WADA accredited laboratory in Seibersdorf – Austria and UEFA.

Minister of Youth and Sport of Republic of Serbia Snezana Samardzic Markovic has met representatives of the Austrian police – Doping Related Crime Unit. The initiative for this meeting came from the Minister Snezana Samardzic Markovic, who has expressed her wish and hope that such unit would protect our athletes and professional sport in Serbia from the doping dealers and easy availability of doping substances, which have a devastating impact on health of athletes, results and ethics of sport.

Anti-Doping Agency of Bosnia and Herzegovina hired Doping control Officers as teachers and educators during the training process for 40 DCO who will perform doping controls for ADA BiH. Trainings took place in Sarajevo and Tuzla.
