In accordance with Article 108. Public Procurement Law (“Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia” 124/12, 14/15 and 68/15) and in accordance with Report on expert evaluation of bids no. 25-0326-1, director of Anti-Doping Agency of Serbia adopted the following

**DECISION**  
**on Awarding the Contract**  
**for low-value public procurement of goods**  
**Medical supplies 1. doping control kits for humans 2. doping control kits for horses 3.**  
**accessories for doping control**  
**PP number 1.1.1/2020**

The Contract for public procurement of goods – Medical supplies 1. doping control kits for humans 2. doping control kits for horses 3. accessories for doping control, PP number 1.1.1/2020. is awarded to the bidder Berlinger Special AG, Mitteldorfstrasse 2, CH-9608 Ganterschwil, Switzerland with value of 18489 CHF ie. 2.049.278, 24 dinars without Tax, according to the medium exchange rate of the National Bank of Serbia on the day of the bid opening.

This decision has to be published on Public Procurement Portal and website of Anti-Doping Agency of Serbia within three days from the date of decision

**E x p l a n a t i o n**

1. On 4.3.2020, The Contract Authority adopted Decision No. 25-0304-1 and launched low-value public procurement of goods – Medical supplies 1. doping control kits for humans 2. doping control kits for horses 3. accessories for doping control, PP number 1.1.1/2020.

2. Invitation to submit bids no. 5-0305-2, Contract Authority published on Public Procurement Portal as well as on the contracting authority’s website on 5.3.2020. in accordance with Public Procurement Law. By the deadline for submission of bids, the Contract Authority has received one bid.

3 The public bid opening was conducted on 25.3.2020. in the premises of the Anti-Doping Agency of Serbia, Belgrade, Trg Republike 3, starting at 15.00 hours, in the presence of the Public Procurement Commission, appointed by Decision on Public Procurement Commission no. 25-0304-2 from 4.3.2020.

4. After bid opening procedure, Commission issued Report on expert evaluation of bids no. 25-0326-1 from 26.3.2020. and stated following:

- Subject of public procurement: Medical supplies 1. doping control kits for humans 2. doping control kits for horses 3. accessories for doping control.
- The estimated value of the procurement: 2.729.000 dinars (without Tax).
- Total bids: 1

5. After review and expert evaluation of bids, the Procurement Commission proposes a decision on awarding the contract in favor of the bidder: Berlinger Special AG, Mitteldorfstrasse 2, CH-9608 Ganterschwil, Switzerland for bid no. 2020-SO1069 from 6.3.2020. archived by the Contract Authority under no. 25-0313-1 from 13.3.2020.

6. Given the above, the Director accepted the proposal of the Commission for public procurement, and on the basis of legal authority, bringing the contract award decision cited above.

***Legal remedy: Against this decision, a request for the protection of rights may be submitted to the Contract Authority, within 5 days of publication of decision on Public Procurement Portal. The request shall be submitted to the Contract Authority and a copy shall be at the same time submitted to the Republic Commission for protection of rights in public procurement procedures. The request for protection of rights must contain the elements prescribed by Article 151 of the Public Procurement Law. The applicant is required to pay a tax at the account of the budget of the Republic of Serbia in the amount prescribed by Article 156 Public Procurement Law. In accordance with Article 112, paragraph 2, item 5 of the Public Procurement Law, the Contract Authority may conclude a public procurement contract. before the expiry of the deadline for applications for the protection of the right .***
